

## **Knit Doll Hat and Scarf 1**



**Size 2 (2.75mm) needles**

**Herrschners 2ply size 2 Afghan Yarn.**

**I used Light Teal.**

**My Gauge in Stockinette stitch is 7 stitches and rows to the inch (2.54cm)**

**Stockinette stitch (knit one row, purl one row)**

**To help the scarf lay flat, I used selvedge stitches.**

**Selvedge (slip 1<sup>st</sup> stitch purlwise, knit last stitch) on every row.**

### **HAT**

**Cast on 28 stitches.**

**Rows 1-3 Work rib of knit one purl one for 3 rows.**

**Rows 4-12 Work in stockinette stitch**

**Row 13 Knit 2 stitches together across (14 stitches)**

**Row 14 Purl 2 stitches together across (7 stitches)**

**Do not cast off. Cut yarn leaving a long strand. Pull that strand through each stitch (pulling stitch off needle) then pull tight to gather. Tie off and finish all loose threads. Sew back seam.**

### **SCARF**

**Cast on 9 stitches**

**Row 1 selvedge, knit 7, selvedge**

**Row 2 selvedge, purl 7 selvedge**

**Repeat rows 1 and 2 until scarf =11 inches (27.94 cm)**

**Cast off. Cut thread.**

**Cut 3 in (cm) pieces of thread and tie on each end of scarf for fringe.**
