

Slip Pattern US Terms



This will be tight and sit below the waist. Adjust your original chain to fit.

Row 1. Ch 18 join to form loop.

Row 2. Ch 1, 18 sc in loop, join.

Row 3. Ch 4, 2 tr in each sc around, join.

Row 4. Ch 4, (1 tr in next stitch, 2 tr in next stitch) around, join.

Row 5. Ch 4, tr around, join.

Start Ruffle. I put a bobby pin at the start of each row so I don't lose my place.

Row 6. Ch 1, sc in join, (chain 5 sc in next loop) around, join with ch 3, dc in join sc.

Row 7. Ch 1, sc in join, (chain 5 sc in next loop) around, join with ch 3, dc in dc.

Row 8. Ch 1, sc in join, (chain 5 sc in next loop) around, join with ch 3, dc in dc.

Row 9. Ch 1, sc in join, (chain 5 sc in next loop) around, join with ch 3, dc in dc.

Row 10. Ch 1, sc in join, (chain 5 sc in next loop) around, join in dc. Cut thread.

Slip Pattern UK Terms

This will be tight and sit below the waist. Adjust your original chain to fit.

Row 1. Ch 18 join to form loop.

Row 2. Ch 4, 18 dtr in loop, join.

Row 3. Ch 4, 2 dtr in each dtr around, join.

Row 4. Ch 4, (1dtr in next stitch, 2 dtr in next stitch) around, join.

Row 5. Ch 4, dtr around, join.

Start Ruffle. I put a bobby pin at the start of each row so I don't lose my place.

Row 6. Ch1, dc in join, (chain 5 dc in next loop) around, join with ch 3, tr in dc.

Row 7. Ch1, dc in join, (chain 5 dc in next loop) around, join with ch 3, tr in tr.

Row 8. Ch1, dc in join, (chain 5 dc in next loop) around, join with ch 3, tr in tr.

Row 9. Ch1, dc in join, (chain 5 dc in next loop) around, join with ch 3, tr in tr.

Row 10. Ch1, dc in join, (chain 5 dc in next loop) around, ch 3 join in tr. Cut thread.
