
**Slipper Pin Cushion Pattern** 



I edited this pattern from my collection of vintage patterns to include information about the original thread and where to buy substitutions. I also included a pattern using UK terms for all my overseas friends. This is a vintage pattern and out of copyright in the US. Feel free to use it any way you want. SIZE 10 Lace, Fingering, Bedspread

similar to 0 CYC Lace UK 1ply Australia 2 ply

**Dmc Herrschners lists nine colors** 

Aunt Lydia's Herrschners lists fifty-four colors, Michael's lists twenty-six, Walmart lists one

Redheart Michael's lists five colors, Walmart lists three

Thread Art Walmart list twenty-seven colors

Herrschners Best Herrschners lists twenty colors.

If you want the glitter, you can also add metallic thread.

The least expensive I've found is Coats metallic decorative thread in the sewing thread area at Walmart. It comes in silver and light and dark silver gold.

Just run it along beside the cotton thread when you crochet.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 6 (1.80mm).

A plastic slipper ... 1 large and 1 small seguin and a gold bead.

GAUGE: 8 dc make 1 inch (2.54cm); 3 dc rows make 1 inch (2.54cm). Pattern in US terms.

SOLE ... Starting at center, ch 23.

1st rnd: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 5 ch, dc in next 15 ch, 7 dc in last ch; now, working along opposite side of starting chain, make dc in next 15 ch,

sc in next 6 ch, ch 1. Join.

2nd rnd: Sc in each sc, and dc in each dc around, making 2 dc, tr and 2 dc in center dc of 7-dc group, ch 23 for heel opening, sl st in first sc. Break off. TOP ... Attach thread to center ch of ch 23.

1st rnd: Sc in same place, (ch 5, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch) 3 times; ch 5, sc in next sc, (ch 5, skip 2 sts, sc in next st) 8 times; (ch 5, skip 1 st, sc in next st) twice; (ch 5, skip 2 sts, sc in next st) 8 times; (ch 5, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch) 3 times; ch 2, dc in first sc.

2nd and 3rd rnds: \* Ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 2, dc in dc.

4th rnd: Mark off 6 loops across toe, \* ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from \*, ending with sc in first marked loop, ch 2, dc in next 4 loops, ch 2, sc in next loop, complete rnd. Join as before.

5th rnd: \* Ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* to within ch-2 sp, (ch 3, sc in ch-2 sp) twice; complete rnd, ending with ch 3, sl st in dc.

6th rnd: 3 sc in each loop around, making 1 sc in the center 3 loops across toe. Join and break off.

HEEL ... 1st rnd: Attach thread to first chain of ch-23, sc in same place, sc in each ch around, make 5 sc across straight edge of back.

2nd rnd: (Ch 5, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc) 8 times; sc in each sc across straight edge.

3rd, 4th and 5th rnds: Ch 5, skip next loop, sc in next loop, \* ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* to within last loop, ch 5, skip last loop, sc in each sc across straight edge.

6th rnd: \* Ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* across loops, sc in each sc.

7th rnd: 4 sc in each loop, sc in each sc.

8th rnd: Sc in each sc around.

9th rnd: Picking up back loop only, \* work off 2 sc as 1 sc (twice). Repeat from \* around. Now sl st in every other sc until all sc's have been worked off. Break off. Sew sequins and bead to instep. Slip over plastic slipper.

## Pattern in UK terms.

SOLE ... Starting at center, ch 23.

1st rnd: Dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next 5 ch, tr in next 15 ch, 7 tr in last ch; now, working along opposite side of starting chain, make tr in next 15 ch, dc in next 6 ch, ch 1. Join.

2nd rnd: Dc in each dc, and tr in each tr around, making 2 tr, dtr and 2 tr i n center tr of 7-tr group, ch 23 for heel opening, sl st in first dc. Break off. TOP ... Attach thread to center ch of ch 23.

1st rnd: Dc in same place, (ch 5, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch) 3 times; ch 5, dc in next dc, (ch 5, skip 2 sts, dc in next st) 8 times; (ch 5, skip 1 st, dc in next st) twice; (ch 5, skip 2 sts, dc in next st) 8 times; (ch 5, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch) 3 times; ch 2, tr in first dc.

2nd and 3rd rnds: \* Ch 5, dc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, ending

with ch 2, tr in tr.

4th rnd: Mark off 6 loops across toe, \* ch 5, dc in next loop. Repeat from \*, ending with dc in first marked loop, ch 2, tr in next 4 loops, ch 2, dc in next loop, complete rnd. Join as before.

5th rnd: \* Ch 3, dc in next loop. Repeat from \* to within ch-2 sp, (ch 3, dc in ch-2 sp) twice; complete rnd, ending with ch 3, sl st in tr.

6th rnd: 3 dc in each loop around, making 1 dc in the center 3 loops across toe. Join and break off.

HEEL ... 1st rnd: Attach thread to first chain of ch-23, dc in same place, dc in each ch around, make 5 dc across straight edge of back.

2nd rnd: (Ch 5, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc) 8 times; dc in each dc across straight edge.

3rd, 4th and 5th rnds: Ch 5, skip next loop, dc in next loop, \* ch 5, dc in next loop. Repeat from \* to within last loop, ch 5, skip last loop, dc in each dc acro ss straight edge.

6th rnd: \* Ch 3, dc in next loop. Repeat from \* across loops, dc in each dc.

7th rnd: 4 dc in each loop, dc in each dc.

8th rnd: Dc in each dc around.

9th rnd: Picking up back loop only, \* work off 2 dc as 1 dc (twice). Repeat from \* around. Now sl st in every other dc until all dc's have been worked off.

Break off. Sew sequins and bead to instep. Slip over plastic slipper.
