## Small Flat Ball Crochet Cover 2



## Materials Used:

Lion Brand Summer Nights, Ocean Cove, size 1
This has been discontinued.
I'd use one strand of size 10 crochet cotton worked with one strand of coats metallic sewing thread. A few colors are still available on Amazon. Steel Crochet Hook No. 1 ( $\mathbf{2 . 7 5} \mathbf{~ m m}$ )
Flat Plastic Fillable Ornament 3.15 inch ( $\mathbf{8} \mathbf{~ c m}$ ) Creative Hobbies brand.
Stitches used in US terms
$\mathrm{Ch} / \mathrm{ch}$ chain
Dc/dc double crochet
Sl st/sl st $\quad$ Sl st/sl stSlip stitch
Front in US Terms
Chain 8. Join with sl st to form a ring.
1 st round: Ch 3. Make 15 dc in ring. Sl st to join.
2nd round: Ch 3,dc in same stitch, make 2 dc in each of the next 15 dc. Join with a sl st.
3rd round: Ch 3, 1 dc in same space as chain, ch 3, 2 dc into same space (shell); * skip 3 sts, in next st make ( 2 dc , ch 3, 2 dc -shell); repeat from * aro und. Join with a sl st to 3 rd st of starting ch-4
4th round: Ch 2, * over ch- 3 space make ( 2 dc , ch 3, 2 dc ), ch 2 sc in next
space between 2 shells, ch 2, repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, sl st to base of starting ch-2.
5th round: Sl st into next shell ch 3 , into same space make 6 dc, over the next ch-3 space make 7 dc , repeat from * around, join round with a sl st. Fasten off. Finish loose ends.
Back in US Terms
Chain 8. Join with sl st to form a ring.
1 st round: Ch 3. Make 15 dc in ring. Sl st to join.
2nd round: Ch 3,dc in same stitch, make 2 dc in each of the next 15 stitches. Join with a sl st.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ round: repeat row 2
$4^{\text {th }}$ round: ch $3, * 2$ dc in next st, 1 dc* in next stitch around. Join with sl st.
$5^{\text {th }}$ round: ch 5 , skip 2 sts, dc in next $s t$. *ch 2 , skip 2 stitches, dc in next stitch* around.
Sew the two pieces together over the ball and glue or sew on embellishments to both sides.


Stitches used in UK terms
Ch/ch chain
$\mathrm{Tr} / \mathrm{tr} \quad \mathrm{Tr} /$ trtreble crochet
Ss/ss Slip stitch
Front in UK Terms
Chain 8. Join with ss to form a ring.
1 st round: Ch 3. Make 15 tr in ring. Ss to join.
2nd round: Ch3, tr in same stitch, make 2 tr in each of the next 15 tr . Join with a ss
3rd round: Ch 3, 1 tr in same space as chain, ch 3, 2 tr into same space (shell); * miss 3 sts, in next st make ( 2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr-shell); repeat from * aro und. Join with a ss to 3rd st of starting ch-4
4th round: Ch 2, * over ch-3 space make ( 2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr), ch 2 sc in next space between 2 shells, ch 2 , repeat from * around, ending with ch 2 , ss to base of starting ch-2.
5th round: Sl st into next shell ch 3, into same space make 6 tr,* over the next ch- 3 space make 7 tr, repeat from * around, join round with a ss. Back in UK Terms

Chain 8. Join with ss to form a ring.
1 st round: Ch 3. Make 15 tr in ring. Ss to join.
2nd round: Ch 3, tr in same stitch, make 2 tr in each of the next 15 stitches. Join with a ss.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ round: repeat row 2
$4^{\text {th }}$ round: ch $3, * 2$ tr in next st, 1 tr* in next stitch around. Join with ss.
$5^{\text {th }}$ round: ch 5, miss $\mathbf{2}$ sts, tr in next st. *ch 2, miss $\mathbf{2}$ stitches, tr in next stitch* around.
Fasten off. Finish loose ends.
Sew the two pieces together over the ball and glue or sew on embellishments to both sides.
