# **Small Flat Ball Crochet Cover 3**



#### **Materials Used:**

Lion Brand Summer Nights, Treasure Island, size 1

This has been discontinued.

I'd use one strand of size 10 crochet cotton worked with one strand of coats metallic sewing thread. A few colors are still available on Amazon. Steel Crochet Hook No. 1 (2.75 mm)

Flat Plastic Fillable Ornament 3.15 inch (8 cm) Creative Hobbies brand.

### Stitches used in US terms

Ch/ch chain

Sc/sc single crochet

Dc/dc Dc/dc double crochet
Trc/trc Trc/trc triple crochet
Sl st/sl st Sl st/sl st Slip stitch

### **Front in US Terms**

Chain 8. Join with sl st to form a ring.

1 st round: Ch 3. Make 14 dc in ring. Sl st to join.

2nd round: Ch 3,dc in same stitch, make 2 dc in each of the dc around. Join

with a sl st.

3rd round: Ch 1, \* 1 sc in each of the next 5 sts, ch 5, skip 1 dc, repeat from \* around; ending with join ing the last ch-5 to the first sc made.

4th round: SI st to the middle sc, \* sc in that sc, ch 1, in the next ch-5 loop make 10 trc with a ch 1 be tween, ch 1, to the middle of 5 sc group; repeat from \* around, ending with ch 1, join with a sI st in first sc made.

5th round: \* sc in next ch-1 space, (ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space) across the trc cluster repeat from \* around. Join with a sl st.

Fasten off. Finish loose ends.

## Chain 8. Join with sl st to form a ring.

1 st round: Ch 3. Make 15 dc in ring. Sl st to join.

2nd round: Ch 3,dc in same stitch, make 2 dc in each of the next 15 stitches.

Join with a sl st.

3<sup>rd</sup> round: repeat row 2

 $4^{th}$  round: ch 3, \*2 dc in next st, 1dc\* in next stitch around. Join with sl st.

5<sup>th</sup> round: ch 5, skip 2 sts., dc in next st. \*ch 2, skip 2 stitches, dc in next stitch\* around.

Sew the two pieces together over the ball and glue or sew on embellishments to both sides.

Chain 8. Join with ss to form a ring.

1 st round: Ch 3. Make 14 tr in ring. Ss to join.

2nd round: Ch3, tr in same stitch, make 2 tr in each of the tr around. Join

with a ss

3rd round: Ch 1, \* 1 dc in each of the next 5 sts, ch 5, miss 1 tr, repeat from \* around: ending with join ing the last ch-5 to the first dc made.

4th round: Ss to the middle dc, \* dc in that dc, ch 1, in the next ch-5 loop make 10 dtr with a ch 1 be tween, ch 1, to the middle of 5 dc group; repeat from \* around, ending with ch 1, ioin with a ss in first dc made.

5th round: \* dc in next ch-1 space, (ch 3, dc in next ch-1 space) across the dtr cluster repeat from \* around. Join with a ss.

## Chain 8. Join with ss to form a ring.

1 st round: Ch 3. Make 15 tr in ring. Ss to join.

2nd round: Ch 3, tr in same stitch, make 2 tr in each of the next 15 stitches.

Join with a ss.

3<sup>rd</sup> round: repeat row 2

4th round: ch 3, \*2 tr in next st, 1tr\* in next stitch around. Join with ss.

5<sup>th</sup> round: ch 5, miss 2 sts, tr in next st. \*ch 2, miss 2 stitches, tr in next stitch\* around.

Fasten off. Finish loose ends.

Sew the two pieces together over the ball and glue or sew on embellishments to both sides.
